The Denver Hospice mission is to encircle those facing advanced illness with unprecedented levels of comfort, compassion, and expertise. We do this through integrity, excellence, and stewardship and by providing comprehensive care for those who have an advanced medical condition, serious illness and those who are grieving.

The Denver Hospice is comprised of 221 team members as well as more than 180 volunteers and Board members who are all committed to building on our existing strengths and growing our services.

Significant highlights from 2023 include:

- Tim Bowen, President and CEO of Care Synergy and The Denver Hospice Board of Directors announced that Ernest Lopez would be joining as the next President of The Denver Hospice.
- We opened a NEW palliative care clinic within The Denver Hospice inpatient care facility to treat those patients who prefer an on-site visit. The new clinic joins our other on-site clinic located in Westminster, Colorado.
- We served more than 1,000 patients and their family/loved ones through grief and loss programs.
- Almost 25% of our patients are military veterans. The Denver Hospice was reaccredited for Level 5 status in the We Honor Veterans campaign, a joint program of the National Hospice and Palliative Care Organization and the Veterans Administration.
